Participants drive both new and classic Ferrari models, with races taking place at renowned circuits across Scandinavia. Each event features practice sessions, qualifying, and competitive races, creating an exciting experience for both drivers and spectators alike.

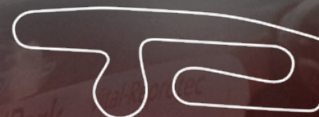
RACING AROUND SCANDINAVIA

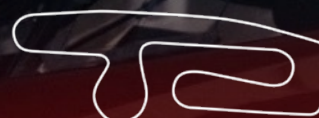

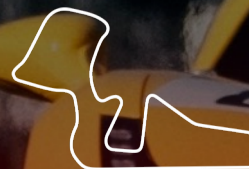

TEST DAY + ROUND 1 & 2

1-2-3 MAY, ANDERSTORP RACEWAY

Get ready for extensive track time and a thrilling double-header at one of Scandinavia's most legendary circuits. For this event, the Formula GT Challenge will share the paddock with Historic Motorsport and the Swedish Sports Car Championship, creating the foundation for an exceptional weekend—one of the largest motorsport gatherings in Sweden in 2026.

Anderstorp Raceway, officially known as Scandinavian Raceway, is a historic motorsport circuit located in Anderstorp, Sweden. Opened in 1968, it quickly became one of the most important racing venues in Northern Europe. During the 1970s and early 1980s, the track hosted the Swedish Grand Prix in Formula 1, attracting legendary drivers such as Niki Lauda, James Hunt, and Ronnie Peterson. Its unique atmosphere and Scandinavian motorsport heritage have made it an iconic location in racing history.

The circuit layout is distinctive, featuring long straights combined with technical corners that challenge both driver and machine. One of the track's most famous features is the long "Flight Straight," originally designed to double as an aircraft runway—something that made the circuit stand out internationally. With a total length of approximately 4.0 km, Anderstorp offers a mix of fast sections, slow hairpins, and flowing curves, making it suitable for a wide range of racing categories.

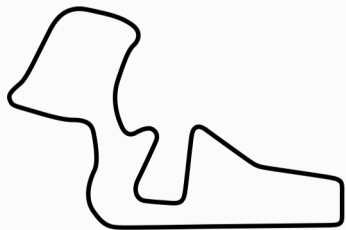
ROUND 3

30 MAY, JYLLANDSRINGEN

This will be a unique one-day event held in cooperation with the prestigious MyGarage Trackday. Despite the condensed schedule, drivers will still enjoy more than 100 minutes of track time—equivalent to a full racing weekend. As this is a joint event, certain special conditions will apply.

Jyllandsringen, located near Silkeborg in central Jutland, is Denmark's most iconic and historic racing circuit. Since its opening in 1966, it has served as the epicenter of Danish motorsport and the home of numerous national championships, including the Danish Touring Car and Super GT series. Over the decades, it has hosted major touring car events and international motorsport festivals, shaping the path of many prominent Danish drivers.

The circuit itself is compact, technical, and highly engaging. Its mix of tight corners, fast sweepers, and natural elevation changes demands precision and strong car control. At just over 2 km, Jyllandsringen consistently delivers close, action-packed racing—one of the many reasons it remains a favorite among both drivers and fans.

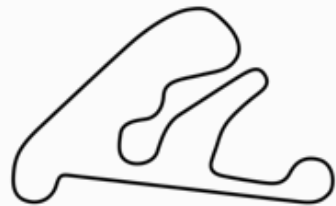
15-16 AUGUST, RUDSKOGEN MOTORSENTER

We are delighted to invite all drivers to Formula Racing Days in Rudskogen - our first edition of what will become an annual gathering for our Danish, Swedish, and Norwegian racing family. This event will be a true celebration of motorsport, featuring trackdays, race days, test drives, and a wide range of activities throughout the paddock.

Rudskogen Motorsenter, located near Rakkestad in southeastern Norway, is the country's oldest and most prestigious permanent racing circuit. Opened in 1990, it has become the heart of Norwegian motorsport, hosting everything from national championships to major international events, including the acclaimed Gatebil festivals that attract drivers and fans from across Europe.

The circuit was redesigned in 2011 by world-renowned track architect Hermann Tilke, resulting in a modern, flowing 3.2 km layout. Its mix of high-speed sections, challenging elevation changes, and technical corner combinations makes it both demanding and rewarding for drivers. Surrounded by scenic forest landscapes, Rudskogen offers a unique blend of natural beauty and motorsport adrenaline.

Today, it stands as Norway's premier racing facility—modern, dynamic, and a key venue for developing the future of Norwegian motorsport.

ROUND 5 - FINAL

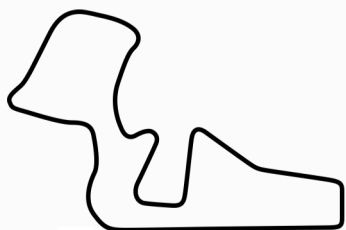
26-27 SEPTEMBER, JYLLANDSRINGEN

THE FORMAT

OPTIMISED AND ADAPTED

The championship is open to all GT cars produced by Ferrari S.p.A., encompassing a wide range of models from historic icons to modern GT3 and Challenge cars. This inclusivity allows both vintage and contemporary vehicles to compete together, celebrating Ferrari's racing heritage.

Drivers are divided into different classes to ensure fair and balanced competition. The size and structure of each class depend on the number of participants, their experience levels, and the types of cars entered. This system allows for close racing among drivers with similar performance capabilities.

Trofeo Pirelli : Overall Championship

Coppa Formula: From 488 Challenge EVO and older

Each round of the championship has free practice session(s), qualify session(s), and sprint races of 20 minutes. The starting grid for Race 2 is determined by the results of Race 1, with the top six finishers reversed to encourage exciting, competitive racing and overtaking opportunities.

While the general format remains consistent, flexibility is built into the schedule to maximize driving time during each race weekend. Adjustments to the program may be made when necessary, and any changes will be clearly communicated through supplementary regulations issued before each event.

DRIVER REQUIREMENTS

WITH OUR PARTICIPANTS IN MIND

All drivers must be at least 18 years old and hold a valid competition license, with a minimum requirement of National Grade B. Each driver is also required to wear approved racing equipment, including a suit, helmet, gloves, and shoes, to ensure safety and compliance with racing standards.

Every car entered in the competition must have a valid vehicle book and must fully comply with the regulations set by the Motorsport Federation. These measures ensure fairness, safety, and adherence to official racing standards.

Participation in the event does not require any prior racing experience, making it accessible to newcomers as well as seasoned drivers. However, practice sessions before the competition are strongly recommended to help drivers familiarize themselves with the track and improve their performance.

All participants are expected to uphold a high standard of behavior throughout the event. Drivers should maintain a friendly and respectful atmosphere, both during and outside of racing sessions. The spirit of the competition emphasizes gentlemanly conduct at all times, fostering sportsmanship and mutual respect on and off the track.

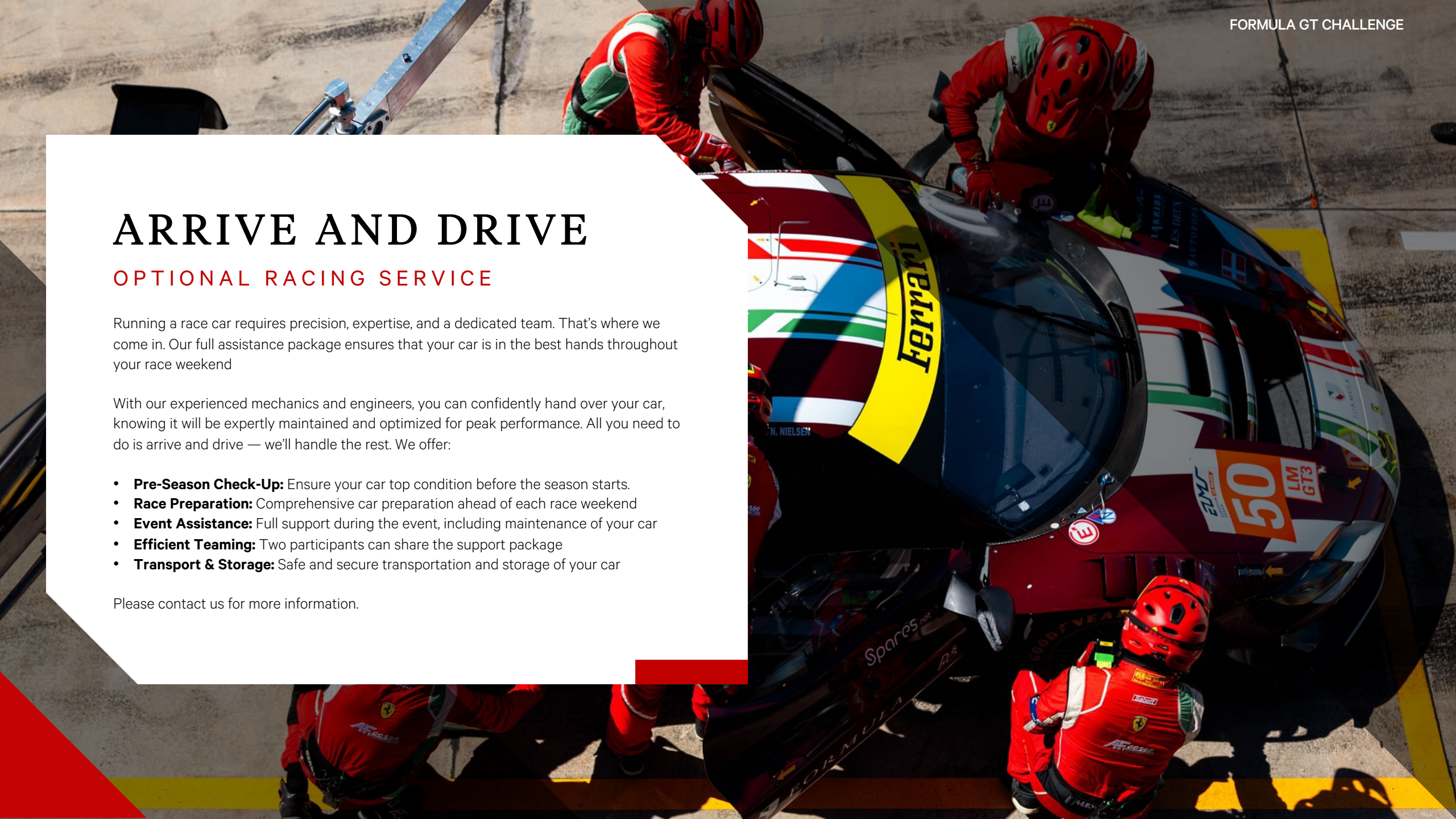
